1. **Goggles:** There are over 100 types of goggles you can choose from, ranging from \$7-\$20. We recommend you <u>choose a shaded, or mirrored goggle</u> because the pool is outdoors.

- 2. **Swim Cap:** Required for girls, and boys with hair past their eyes. They come in latex and silicone. Latex is the least expensive. Silicone is more comfortable. Choose any pattern you like.
- 3. **Swim Suit:** one piece suit for the girls is required. Boys may choose between trunks, jammers, or a brief











4. **Chamois Sport Towel:** Regular towels will mildew in the locker. We recommend using a sport towel similar to what you see below. There are many to choose from, but any will work.







- 5. **Combination lock:** The lock must have a number combination
